


# Creating a Turnitin Assignment in Moodle

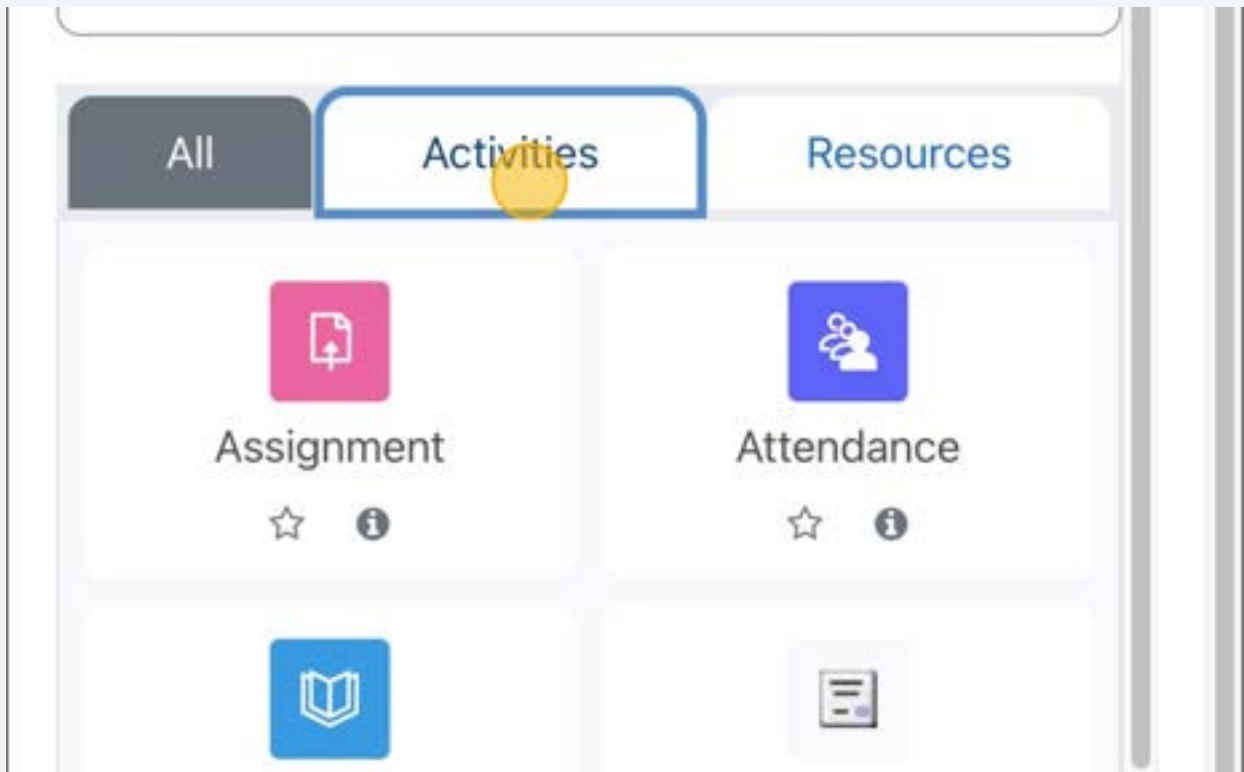
1 Make sure "Edit mode" is toggled on.

**Click "Add an activity or resource."**

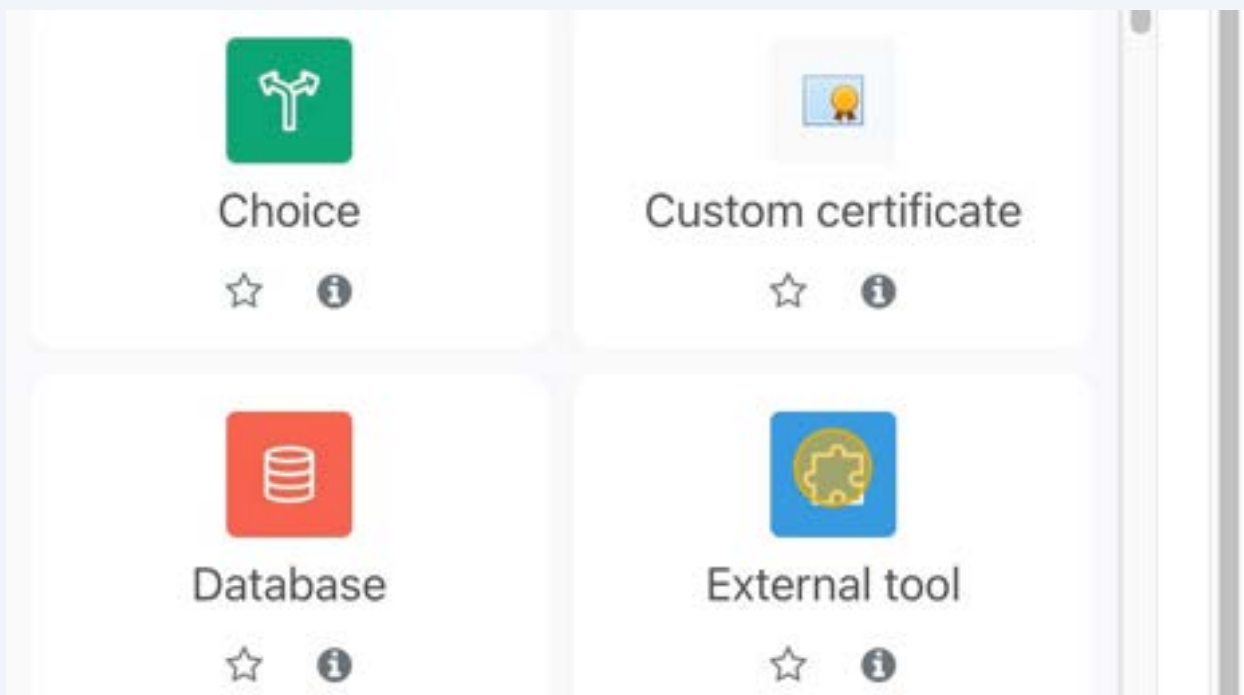
